Mt. Kenya and Masai Mara takes you through three diverse parks with our top English speaking driver/ guides. Using four-wheel-drive safari vehicles throughout, the tour travels at a comfortable pace allowing you plenty of time for exploration. including posing for photo on the equator. Game viewing by floodlight at the tree lodge is a treat.

Returning to Nairobi at noon permits travelers to easily extend to other parts of Kenya or beyond.

In 1952, Treetops became famous for being the site where Princess Elizabeth became Queen.

Day 1: Arrival in Nairobi, Kenya

KARIBU KENYA! Welcome to Kenya!

Arrive Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (NBO) in Nairobi, Kenya. Airport Meet and Greet and then transfer to Arusha Hotel for overnight.

Day 2: Nairobi –Aberdares

From Nairobi, head north passing near Thika which boasts one the world's third largest pineapple plantation and home to Del Monte, and Karatina with its colorful market. Soon you'll be at Nyeri, one of Kenya's major towns and provincial headquarters before going into the forests of the Aberdare Mountain range arriving at the Outspan Hotel for lunch. Later in the afternoon you'll transfer to Treetops. This is a tree lodge set in a forest glade with a waterhole that attracts all sorts of wildlife during the day and night. The waterhole is floodlit and there is an underground viewing platform. Dinner and overnight. *(BLD)*

Day 3: Aberdares - Lake Nakuru

An early morning start first takes you north-west heading towards Nyahururu where several of the famous Kenyan runners are from. Turn in a southerly direction to your next destination, the spectacular Lake Nakuru. Once in the park, game drive en-route to your lodge. Following lunch you'll have an afternoon game drive. The national park, known for its birdlife, is also home to black and white rhinos as well as the endangered Rothschild Giraffe. Dinner and overnight. *(BLD)*

Day 4: Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara Game Reserve

After breakfast, drive to Narok town via Mai-Mahiu where you will have a brief a rest stop. Proceed on to the 'Mara' arriving in time for lunch at your lodge. After lunch, depart for an afternoon game drive looking for the big cats and – lion, leopard and cheetah. Return back to the lodge for dinner and overnight. *(BLD)*

Day 5: Masai Mara Game Reserve

Optional morning Hot Air Balloon. Enjoy the abundance of wildlife – elephant, buffalo, zebra, giraffe and hyena – on your morning and afternoon game drives. The world's greatest wildlife spectacle – The Great Migration – comes into the Masai Mara from July through October. After your wonderful day return to the lodge for dinner and overnight. *(BLD)*

Day 6: Masai Mara Game Reserve – Nairobi

After breakfast depart the Masai Mara and head across acres of rolling wheat and barley farms to Narok, the district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. From here cross the vast plains on the floor of the Rift Valley before heading up the rift escarpment. Arrive into Kenya's bustling capital in the early afternoon. A day room is there for you until your evening departure to the airport. *(BL)*
